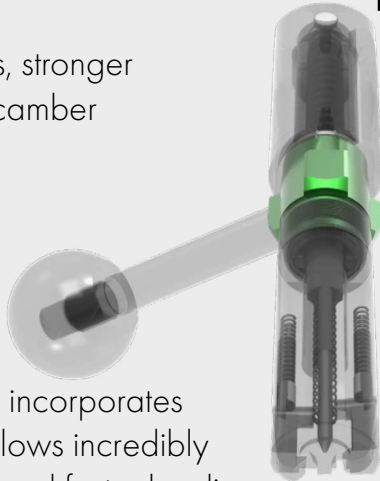

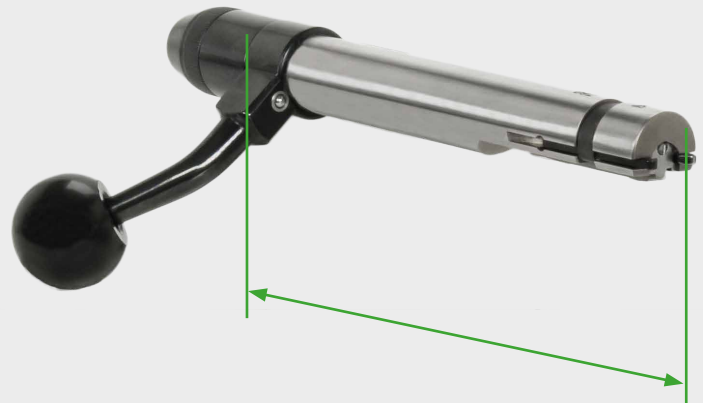
## BOLT

Three-Locking lugs, stronger and closer to the camber

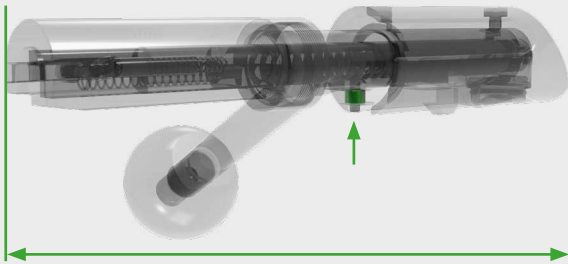
Shorter bolt which incorporates a small bearing allows incredibly smooth repeating and fast reloading

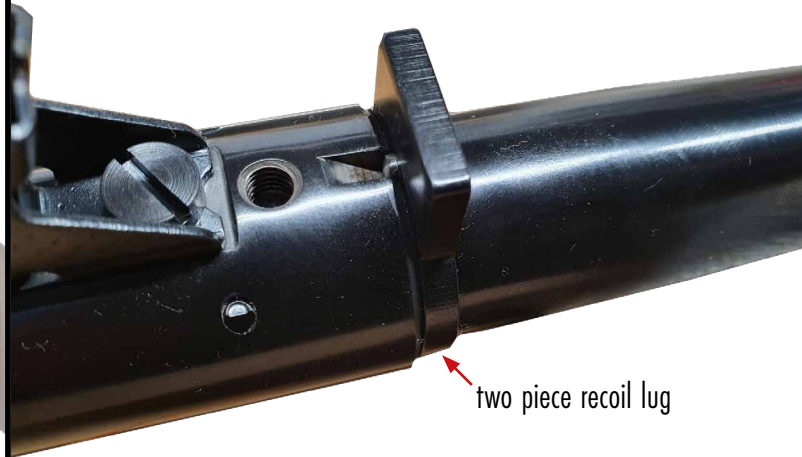
